# Happy Father's Day



Dear Parishioners,

**1. Being Able to Hear**

*In the Gospel Reading, Jesus does a miracle: a man who was deaf and impaired in speech becomes able to hear and to speak plainly. But the way in which Jesus performs the miracle seems undignified or even silly. Jesus puts his fingers in the man's ears and his spit on the man's tongue. Before the man's ears are opened to hear, Jesus looks up to heaven, he groans, and he says "Be opened!"*

*What happened to the elegant kind of miracle where Jesus just says a word and a person is healed? Why this show, which looks embarrassing for Jesus?*

*The answer lies in the question. What Jesus does is literally a silent show. It has to be. Jesus is trying to communicate with someone who can't hear. In other cases, before Jesus does a miracle, Jesus talks to the person for whom the miracle will be done. In this case, he does charades.*

*His charades begin by letting the deaf man know that Jesus is putting a part of himself into the deaf man—his fingers into the deaf man's ears, his spit into the deaf man's mouth. By this means, Jesus invites the deaf man to accept Jesus into himself—literally. And then Jesus looks up to heaven to show the deaf man the source of Jesus' power. It doesn't come from some magic in Jesus' fingers or spittle. It comes from God, whose power is in Jesus, who is in the deaf man, by means of this charade.*

*Even the groaning and the speech of Jesus to the*



deaf man make sense if we think of them in this way. First, the deaf man sees Jesus open his mouth to make the inarticulate sound of groaning. This deaf man doesn't speak, but even those made mute by deafness can groan. In groaning, Jesus joins the deaf man, who can see Jesus groaning even if he can't hear him.

And then the deaf man sees Jesus speaking an articulate word to him, to the man who cannot hear. In doing this, Jesus is inviting the deaf man to trust in Jesus, to choose to accept the miracle—to choose to hear the word that Jesus speaks to him.

And so Jesus humbles himself to share the limitations of this one deaf man. By undignified dumb show, the love of the Lord heals the deaf man's soul as well as his ears. Let us be humble enough to hear the love of the Lord in this story.

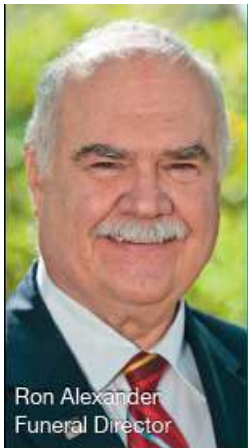

## POPE'S COLUMN



*Pope at Audience: No Economic, Political Engineering Can Substitute Families' Contribution*

*Speaks on Importance of Families Giving Witness in Societies 'Often Marked by Impersonalism, Spiritual Aridity'*

*"The family's covenant with God is called today to oppose the communal desertification of the modern city. But our cities have become like deserts because of lack of love, because of a lack of smiles. So many amusements, so many things to pass time, to make one laugh, but love is lacking. A family's smile is capable of overcoming this desertification of our cities."*

*Speaking to the thousands of faithful gathered in St. Peter's Square for his weekly General Audience, Pope Francis said this as he continued his catechesis on the family, specifically reflecting on the importance of families for spreading the faith, which helps build a more human society.*

*The Holy Father reminded those gathered how Jesus, while affirming the primacy of faith in God, referred to his disciples as his brothers, sisters and mothers.*

*In the Christian life, these family ties are transformed and enlarged; as spiritual fathers and mothers, as brothers and sisters to one another, and particularly to those in need, we bring the Father's love to our world.*

*When we do this, Francis explained, we become a blessing, a sign of hope for the renewal of all social relations.*

*Within families, the Holy Father reminded those gathered that faith becomes a powerful force for unity and love. Moreover, he added how faith inspires a convincing witness to the Gospel. "How important is this witness in our societies, so often marked by impersonalism and spiritual aridity!" he observed.*

*"No economic or political engineering is able to substitute this contribution of families. The Babel project builds skyscrapers without life. Instead, God's Spirit makes deserts flower," Francis said.*

*Before concluding, Pope Francis said all should pray for all families, and like the wine of the wedding feast of Cana, that they bring happiness, joy and the warmth of God's love to our world.*
