### 1. Persons All the Way Down

Christians believe in one God and only one God. But the heart of Christianity is the belief that this one God is three Persons, the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. We count only one God. But when we count divine Persons, we count three.



One way to think about the doctrine of the Trinity is to recognize that it is not possible to stop counting in this funny way.

You can't divide the one God into three more fundamental things, which make up the one God. God isn't a compound of anything more fundamental. One is all there is, when it comes to God.

But then you still have to count three. The three Persons of the Trinity are not really anything else. They aren't roles of God, or modes of God. You can't reduce the three Persons of the Trinity to some more fundamental something in order to get—at bottom—just one. In themselves, they are just Persons, and there are three of them.

And nonetheless these three are still only one.

Some non-believing secular thinkers suppose that everything whatsoever is reducible to elementary particles. For these secularists, at the ultimate foundation of reality there is just the impersonal, the cold and uncaring bits of matter that make up the material world.

But what the doctrine of the Trinity tells us is just the opposite. At the ultimate foundation of all reality, irreducible to bits of matter or to anything else, there are the three Persons of the Trinity.

There is a story told about an old lady who believed that the world is flat and rests on the back of a giant turtle. When she was challenged with the question, "Yes, but what does the turtle rest on?" she said nonchalantly, "Oh, it's turtles all the way down!"

She was wrong, of course, but the secularists are wrong, too. The whole cosmos rests on the loving and caring Persons of the Trinity. For Christians, it's Persons all the way down.

This is a doctrine worth celebrating.

### 2. The Rose Gallagher Project

Many of us from All Hallows knew our fellow parishioner Rose Gallagher. We knew her as a compassionate woman with a strong sense of family, faith, self and social justice. She lived in Five Dock all her life after moving from the Riverina in 1925 and was educated at Domremy College.



Rose was a woman of action. She believed in giving people a helping hand, not a handout. Accordingly she left her Estate to benefit young people who may not have experienced the love, nurturing and security that characterised her own childhood.

CatholicCare Sydney is in the final stages of completing the building of two beautiful new homes in the Five Dock area which are to be used for the use of vulnerable youth.

These houses will be operated by Catholic-Care's ALIVE (Adults Living Independently Via Empowerment) programs and will provide affordable transitional housing for vulnerable young people who have left Out-of-Home-Care and who require support and are at risk of becoming homeless.

All Hallows Parish is attempting to raise money to go towards the furnishing of these houses. We will attempt to do this in particular through a dinner later this year as well as other fundraising initiatives.

With the Five Dock project near completion, Rose Gallagher continues to make a difference in the lives of young people in need. Please mark in your diaries that a fundraiser dinner will be held on Friday 9th October. Keep a look out in the bulletin for more information in the coming weeks.

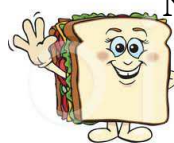

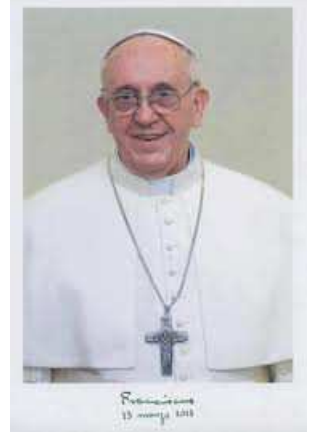


## POPE'S COLUMN

### Pope's Morning Homily: Warns Against Worldly, Indifferent Christians

#### During Mass at Santa Marta, Speaks About 3 Types of Christians

Pope Francis is calling on the faithful to examine what type of Christians they are. During his daily morning Mass at Casa Santa Marta, the Holy Father stressed that there are three key groups of Christians and underscored that Christ's followers are to always bring others closer to him, never create distance.



The Pontiff reflected on today's Gospel from Mark in which Jesus heals the blind man, who others tried to silence. Bartimaeus, approaches Jesus, who asks what can He do for him. After Bartimaeus told Jesus that he wished to see, the Lord said, 'Go your way; your faith has saved you.' Immediately, the blind man received his sight and followed Jesus.

The Pontiff suggested that from this reading, we can learn about three types of Christians. The first group, Francis pointed out, is concerned with their own relationship with Jesus, but is indifferent to others around them.

"This group of people, even today, do not hear the cry of so many people who need Jesus. A group of people who are indifferent: they do not hear, they think that life is their own little group; they are content; they are deaf to the clamour of so many people who need salvation, who need the help of Jesus, who need the Church. These people are selfish, they live for themselves alone. They are unable to hear the voice of Jesus."

The second group the Holy Father also criticized, saying they do "not want to hear the cry for help, but prefer to take care of their business, and use the people of God, use the Church for their own affairs." Francis said they "do not bear witness."

"They are Christians in name, parlour room Christians, Christians at receptions, but their interior life is not Christian, it is worldly. Someone who calls himself Christian and lives like a worldling drives away those who cry out for help from Jesus."

"And then there are the rigorists," he continued, "those whom Jesus rebukes, those who place such heavy weights on the backs of the people. Jesus devotes the whole of the 23rd chapter of St. Matthew to them: 'Hypocrites,' he says to them, 'you exploit the people!' And instead of responding to the cries of the people who cry out for salvation, they send them away."

The group we ought to imitate is the third group of Christians, the Pope noted, namely that group which helps others approach the Lord, and draws people closer to Him.

"There is the group that has coherence among that which they believe and how they live, and help [people] approach Jesus, the people that shout, asking salvation, asking for grace, asking for spiritual health for their soul," the Pope said.

The Holy Father concluded, calling on the faithful to make an examination of conscience and to see whether they draw people closer to Jesus or not.
